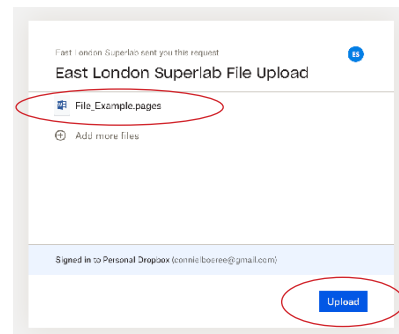

## How to Upload Your File to Dropbox

1. Select "Upload File Here"

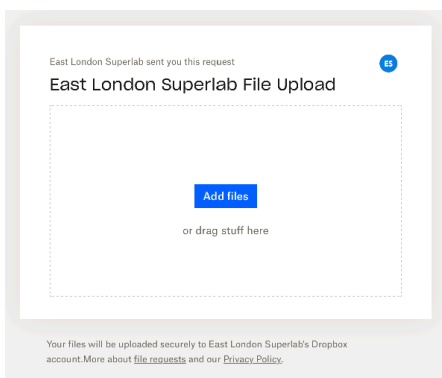


4. Once your file is uploaded, select the "Upload" button.

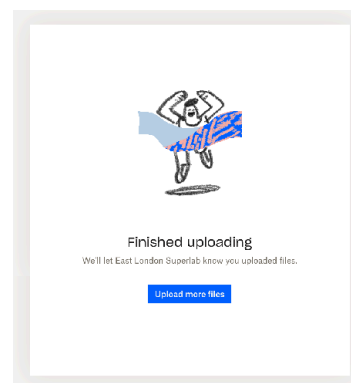


2. Dropbox will open in your browser.

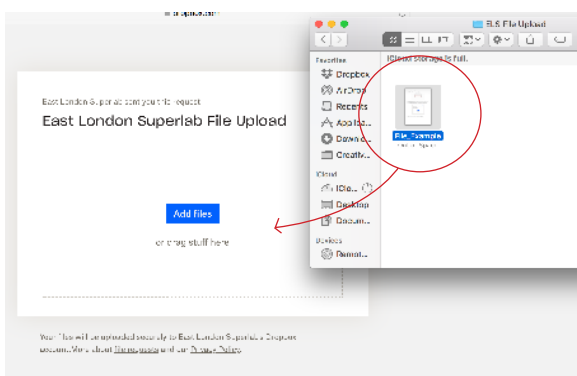
*You do not need a dropbox account to upload your file.*



5. You will be notified on screen when your file is uploaded.



3. You can then drag your file into the drop box.



6. When you upload a file, you must send us an email to notify us with your name, the name of the file you have uploaded.

***If you do not do this, your file will be deleted from our server and your print will not be completed.***


*If your file is larger than 2GB, you will not be able to upload it to the dropbox we have provided. In this case, please email us and we will get back to you with a separate arrangement.*

## Preparing Your File

**What is an ICC profile?**

An ICC profile will enable you to maximise the print quality and reproduce accurately the original colours, by calibrating the printer settings prior to printing.

Because each paper has a slightly different shade, surface structure and reacts differently, it is important that use the ICC profile that is specifically designed for this paper.

**Profile installation**

Save the icc profile in the correct location on your computer so that the application can access it:

- Mac OS X : /Library/ColorSync/Profiles
- Mac OS 9.x : System Folder/ColorSync Profiles
- Windows 2000, XP, Vista : \Windows\system32\spool\drivers\color

You can right-click on the ICC profile and choose to install

Important Note: If you are replacing a profile in Windows XP, the above shortcut does not work. The profiles must be manually copied to the correct directory for the original profile to be replaced.
